The lighting master plan for a large scale urban redevelopment in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia employs a fixture system to deliver path and roadway lighting linking distinctively illuminated public spaces. The lighting system responds to a wide variety of spatial conditions through lamping, mounting and accessory options while maintaining a consistent appearance that reinforces neighborhood character throughout the restored urban quarter. Neighborhood squares and plazas have higher light levels and are accented with color. Sculptural luminaires, visible from key neighborhood entry-points and paths, dramatize public gathering spaces with a playful interplay of light, shadow, and color.
